Sun Coast Senior Jamz Tournament Rules

1. This tournament shall be known as the “Sun Coast Senior Jamz Tournament,” conducted by Tournament Director, **Suheil Jammal, II**. This is a “**JAMZ TOURNAMENT LLC**” event. **All bowlers whose total prize winnings total over \$2,000.00 will be required to provide a mailing address and Social Security Number once results are final and exact prize winnings are known. Should this apply to you, you will be required to call Suheil Jammal, II, Tournament Director, at 321-356-4290 to provide the required information before checks will be released. Thanks!**
2. **Eligibility:** This event is sanctioned with the United States Bowling Congress (USBC), and all bowlers must be currently sanctioned with the USBC. No new sanction cards will be issued during this event; all bowlers must have their USBC card on hand. All bowlers must be 50 years of age or older by July 1, 2026. Only (1) PBA National Title holder per Team and/or Doubles Pair OR (1) PWBA National Title holder per Team and/or Doubles Pair.
3. **Events & Handicaps:** Team event with (4) bowlers per team, all men, all women, or any mix; Doubles event; Singles event; Optional All Events Scratch; Optional All Events Handicap; and Optional Singles Scratch. For the Team Event, Doubles Event, and Singles Event, each bowler will bowl (3) games plus handicap based on 90% of the difference of the bowler’s entering average from 230, per game. Doubles and Singles (all 6 games) will be bowled on the same squad on the same pair of lanes, with the Doubles Event bowled first. All bowlers must enter BOTH Doubles and Singles; no exceptions.
4. **Entering Average:** All averages must be 21 games or more as posted on USBC’s bowl.com, with highest average utilized, including summer averages, as follows, in order of priority: (1) 2024-2025 season average; or (2) 2023-2024 posted season average. If a bowler does not have a posted average from Category (1) and/or (2), then the 2025-2026 average may be utilized at the discretion of the Tournament Director, or the bowler will bowl scratch. All bowlers are subject to being re-rated at the discretion of the Tournament Director, including utilizing current league averages. Sport/Challenge averages will be utilized, with adjustment per USBC conversion charts. **ON THE 2025-2026 SEASON, IF ANY BOWLER IS CURRENTLY AVERAGING 10 PINS OR MORE HIGHER THAN THEIR HIGHEST POSTED AVERAGE PER THE RULES, THEN THAT AVERAGE MUST BE REPORTED AND WILL BE UTILIZED FOR THIS EVENT, EVEN IF IT IS NOT POSTED ON BOWL.COM.** If you have ever been re-rated in ANY tournament, sanctioned or not, in the past 10 years, whether you accepted the re-rate or not, you must report such re-rate to the Tournament Director for possible consideration of a re-rate. Failure to report plus 10 averages and/or re-rated averages may result in a disqualification and a score of zero for any events bowled with no refund issued.
5. **Late Arrivals/Absent Bowlers & Substitutions:** Bowlers who arrive late will receive a score of (0) until they are present and ready to bowl. Absent bowlers receive a score of (0). Team Captains must step forward as early as possible on each squad with any substitute bowler present with USBC card in hand. The substitution goes in the place of the original bowler, and no line-up changes will be allowed in any event.
6. **Lane Conditions:** The lanes will be stripped and oiled for each squad with the same pattern as provided by Bowlero Spring Hill Lanes in consultation with the Tournament Director. No information will be provided regarding the lane conditions.
7. **Entry Fees & Break Down:** The entry fee, per bowler, for the Team Event, Doubles Event, and Singles Event is \$40.00 for each event, or \$120.00 for all three events. Of the \$40.00 amount, \$22.00 will be allocated into the respective Prize Fund; \$18.00 will be allocated for Lineage/Expenses. For the Optional All Events Scratch, All Events Handicap, and Singles Scratch, the entry fee per bowler is \$20.00 for each event with \$17.00 allocated into the respective prize fund and \$3.00 allocated for Expenses.
8. **Unlimited Entries:** Bowlers may enter as many times as they like, paying the fee for each event, of course. For the Team Event, the exact same team cannot bowl together more than once, and at least two bowlers must be changed out. For the Doubles & Singles Event, the exact same pairing cannot bowl together more than once. For any bowler that bowls more than once in the Team Event, only the first (3) games bowled will be utilized to complete the All Events Scores. For any bowler that bowls more than once in the Doubles & Singles Event, only the first (6) games bowled will be utilized to complete the All Events Scores. If anyone bowls twice in Team and twice in Doubles & Singles, that is considered to separate set of (9) games, and therefore, two separate All Events Scores. In this case, the bowler could enter all options twice and cash more than once.
9. **Sponsors:** Some of the sponsor funding, will be utilized to seed the “Queen of Hearts” game. In addition, some of the sponsor funding may be utilized to supplement the three main bowling event (Team, Doubles, and Singles), as well as the Optional events. The exact allocations, if any, will be noted in the final prize fund distribution.
10. **Entry Fee Methods & Deadlines:** You may enter this event in one of two ways: 1). Mail your entry to **Suheil Jammal, II, Tournament Director, 1108 Sweetbriar Road, Orlando, FL 32806. Include your check or money order made payable to Suheil Jammal, II.** 2.) If you would like to pay electronically via Zelle, you may call me at 321-356-4290, between the hours of 11am and 4pm, 7 days a week, and I will process your entry. Before calling, you must have a completed entry form filled out in front of you which enables the transfer of information to occur very easily and quickly. During this phone call, you will pay electronically as follows: **Zelle to 321-356-4290.** The deadline to enter this event is July 5, 2026; however, the deadline may be extended. Feel free to call me beforehand to ensure the squad you want is available, and if so, have your entry form fully completed so all information can be transferred over the phone or emailed to me. Squad availability will also be posted on the website: TheJamzTournament.com. Once there, click “Sun Coast Senior Jamz” tab. Availability will also be posted on my Facebook page, which is Suheil Jammal, II.
11. **Cash Ratios & Prize Fund Distributions:** Of the total entries in the Team Event, Doubles Event, Singles Event, and all Optional Events, 1 in 7 cash. Any bowlers who cash will either have their checks mailed to the Team Captain, with the Team Captain responsible for distribution of those checks, or checks will be mailed directly to the individual bowler. In addition, some bowlers may pick up their checks in person if arrangements are made beforehand.
12. **Optional “Side Action” Events:** \$5.00 Scratch & Handicap Men’s Brackets, \$5.00 Handicap Women’s Brackets, \$20.00 High Game Scratch & Handicap Pots, (includes Game 1, 2, and 3), \$10.00 Mystery Score for Games 1 and 2 only; “Quick Shot” (strike) Jackpot; and “Queen of Hearts” game. Complete rules for these events will be posted at the check-in table. The Quick Shot Jackpot is partially explained below in rule #14.
13. **Quick Shot (QS) Jackpot Partial Rules:** These are partial QS rules; complete rules will be available at the check in table, with a general explanation announced prior to each squad’s starting time for practice. The QS requires a minimum buy-in of \$5.00, good for (2) tickets. As an incentive, for each \$10.00 buy-in, you will receive (5) tickets. There is no limit on the buy-in. One ticket will be drawn. The bowler holding the ticket must strike the next time up in tournament play, and if so, the bowler wins the jackpot. If no strike, bowler receives a consolation prize estimated at \$20.00 per pin knocked down, and approximately 15% of the pot is deducted for a carryover pool for the next Jamz Tournament in August/September 2026. Then continual tickets will be drawn with no further deduction on each squad until a bowler bowls a strike to win the jackpot or the jackpot is exhausted from consolation prizes. Some squads may feature a seeding of the jackpot pool, and this will be announced before any tickets are sold. Approximately 80%-85% of sales comprise the jackpot for each squad, plus added money, if any. Approximately 15%-20% of sales are allocated towards Tournament Take.
14. USBC rules will apply. Any situations not covered here will be rendered by the Tournament Director, Suheil Jammal, II, and those decisions shall be final.

Sun Coast Senior Jamz Tournament

From Suheil Jammal, II, Tournament Director

The “Sun Coast Senior Jamz Tournament” returns to Bowlero Spring Hill, in Spring Hill, Florida. The entry fee, per event, will increase from \$38.00 to \$40.00, due to lineage increases, and my expenses to run this event, given the exceptional growth! The All Events Options and Scratch Singles will remain at \$20.00 per event. Entries will open on April 10, 2026.

ENTRY PRE-REGISTRATION: When I was asked to take over this event 5 years ago, the only restriction I was bound by was that some team captains who have supported this event over many years were to be given pre-registration before entries actually open. This was previously done, and it applied to about six Team Captains, all which have large groups, all of which have grown, and all of which are still bowling. In fact, each year, after they have bowled, they are booking spots for next year. As a result, this is why the final weekend of squads on Saturday at 2pm and Sunday at 9am always show as “sold out” or nearly sold out, prior to entries opening. Therefore, I would STRONGLY SUGGEST you do not plan to bowl on those 2 specific squads. This is one reason a 3rd weekend was added earlier into July.

NEW IRS RULES: Beginning in 2026, the IRS has raised the reportable level of prize winnings from \$600.00 to \$2,000.00. Last year, 18 of you fell into \$600.00+ category. Using the new figure, only 1 person would have had to report that income. In other words, if you win \$2,000.00 or less, there is no 1099 that will be issued. Also, each year, the IRS will be reviewing the threshold, pending inflation, and the amount may increase.

Last year, this event set a record on team count over any of the previous 48 years of this event. Thanks to all of you for your support! This is why I’ve been able to add a full 3rd weekend earlier into July, just as I did last year.

Now that the Sun Coast Senior Jamz Tournament is part of “The Jamz Tournament LLC” series, it is part of the five events that I conduct annually in Central Florida. And now, many of you are bowling those events. You can check out all five events on the website: TheJamzTournament.com. Just click the “Schedule Of Events” tab.

Since taking over this event for the first time in 2022, my goal was to inject a “Jamz” vibe, if you will, which consists of what I feel we all need anyway: BOWLING, of course, more money, more fun, some laughs, some great competition, some unique side action, and just a little more overall energy. As a senior bowler myself, I feel tournaments need more liveliness these days. Clearly, judging from your feedback, you are enjoying it as well. This is actually the same vibe I initiated in all five of my leagues about 13 years ago, and of course, into all of The Jamz Tournaments, which began in 2019. I am beyond thrilled what is occurring with this event and with the incredible growth we are seeing.

Once again, no host hotel will be secured for this event. Why, you ask? The majority of you stay where you want to stay, anyway, and many of you select a certain hotel so you can earn member/reward points. I’ve stayed at 3 different hotels, and each time, I saw many, many bowlers also staying there as well. As a result, the real need for a host hotel is not necessary, in my opinion. And the rates are so similar, and the discount was minimal.
