CashApp: **\$TheJamzTournament** NEW: All CashApp transactions now require a 2.6% markup to cover fees now charged to business entities, such as The Jamz Tournament, LLC. This equates to a markup of \$5.20 per \$200 submission, which is \$5.20 per team entered. Example: If you have 5 teams entered, and pay by CashApp, you would be required to pay \$1,026.00 in total.

The Jamz Tournament Rules

1. This tournament shall be known as "The Jamz Tournament," conducted by Tournament Director, **Suheil Jammal, II**.
2. **Format:** Team event; (4) bowlers per team, all men, all women, or any mix. Bowl (3) games plus handicap based on 90% of the difference of the bowler's entering average from 230, per game. This event is not USBC sanctioned.
3. **Eligibility:** All bowlers must be 18 years of age or older. No USBC youth bowlers allowed. Only (1) PBA National Title holder per team OR (1) PWBA National Title holder per team.
4. **Entering Average:** All averages must be 30 games or more, unless otherwise noted, as posted on USBC's bowl.com and summer league averages count, in order or priority: (1) The highest average from the 2025-2026 season OR the highest average from the 2024-2025 season, WHICHEVER IS HIGHER; (2) The highest current average on the 2025-2026 season, either as posted or verifiable from league sheets and/or online resources such as LeagueSecretary, LeaguePals, etc. Sport/Challenge averages will be considered, with adjustment per USBC conversion charts, less 5 pins. **In all cases, bowlers are subject to being re-rated at the discretion of the Tournament Director. On the current 2025-2026 season, if any bowler has 15 games or more and is averaging 10 pins or more higher than their highest average from Item (1) or (2), then that average must be reported and will be utilized for this event. If any bowler has been re-rated or refused a re-rate in the past 10 years, whether in a sanctioned tournament or unsanctioned tournament, then that average must be reported for consideration of a re-rate by the Tournament Director. In the event a bowler fails to report their correct average, the bowler will either be re-rated in entirety for team and singles standings, or the bowler will be disqualified with a score of zero for all games, with no refunds issued.**
5. **Squad Dates/Times:** Two weekends: August 28-30, 2026, and September 4-7, 2026. Squad times for the 1st weekend are Friday at 8pm, Saturday at 12pm, 4pm, and 8pm; and Sunday at 12pm and 4pm. Squad times for the 2nd weekend are Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, 12pm, 4pm, and 8pm, and Monday (Labor Day Holiday) at 12pm and 4pm. Bowlers who arrive late will receive a score of (0) until they are present and ready to bowl.
6. **Lane Conditions:** The lanes will be stripped and oiled for each squad with the same pattern as provided by Bowlero Altamonte in consultation with the Tournament Director. No information will be made available about the pattern utilized.
7. **Team Entry Fee & Break Down:** The entry fee, per bowler, per squad, is \$50.00, or \$200.00 per team. Of the \$50.00 amount, \$33.00 will be allocated into the Team Prize Fund; and \$17.00 will be allocated for Lineage/Tournament Expenses. Promotional/free entries for the Singles Options may be provided to individuals sponsoring this event or Team Group Leaders who field numerous teams.
8. **Singles Options: Men's Scratch, Men's Handicap, Women's Scratch, Women's Handicap, Senior's Scratch, and Senior's Handicap.** Bowlers may elect to participate in the Men's Scratch Singles, Men's Handicap Singles, Women's Scratch Singles, Women's Handicap Singles, Senior's Scratch Singles, and Senior's Handicap Singles. The same 3 game series from the current squad will be utilized. The cost to enter each is \$25.00 and is payable in cash only for each squad you opt into on the day of each squad. Scores only count for each squad paid for. Of the \$25.00 entry fee, \$22.00 will go towards the Singles Prize Fund, \$3.00 will go towards Tournament Expenses. For the Senior's Singles, you must be at least 50 years of age or older, with ID shown upon during sign-up. You can cash unlimited in this, with some restrictions, per Rule #11 below.
9. **Sponsor Funding Information:** Sponsor funding, if any, may be allocated at the discretion of the Tournament Director, and/or as requested by the sponsor. Such funding may supplement side action such as the "Queen Of Hearts" game.
10. **Entry Fee Methods & Deadlines:** ENTRIES OPEN JUNE 10, 2026, at 11:00am. To reserve your spots, you must call or text me at 321-356-4290. Team Captains may be required to pay a non-refundable \$50.00 deposit per squad desired. This is applied to your team entry fee of \$200.00, leaving a balance due of \$150.00 per spot, due on a date you will be provided with when you book spots. Should you drop out, at any point, no matter the excuse, there are no refunds, no exceptions. Should you drop out of any squads you have not paid the deposit for, there will be a \$50.00 fee charged per squad returned. DO NOT BOOK MORE THAN YOU CAN HANDLE! Payments are to be sent via ZELLE to 321-356-4290, or by CashApp to \$TheJamzTournament. If paying by CashApp, a mark-up of 2.6% will be required for the total fee sent on all transactions, per business regulations from CashApp. I will also accept cash, check, or money order in person, as well as checks and money orders in the mail. **However, if you plan to mail in your entry, you MUST CALL ME at 321-356-4290, to ensure the squad is not sold out.** Checks or money orders are payable to **Suheil Jammal, II. Mail entries to Suheil Jammal, II, Tournament Director, 1108 Sweetbriar Road, Orlando, Florida, 32806.** There is no deadline to enter unless announced; however, you are encouraged to enter early, as squads have sold out quickly in the past. Walk-in entries/re-entries accepted, pending availability, with payment in cash only.
11. **Cash Ratio, Limitations, & Prize Fund Distributions:** Of the total team entries, 1 in 7 cash. Total pins plus handicap determines standings, from high to low, 1st place through the final paid position. If any team bowls more than once with the exact same four bowlers, they may only cash once in the top 5 positions and multiple times in positions 6 and lower. For the Singles options, 1 in 7 cash, and bowlers may cash once in the top 5, and unlimited times in positions 6 and lower. In case of a tie for any position, in any event, including 1st place, prize monies will be added together and split evenly. For teams that cash, checks will be mailed to the Team Captain, upon which the Team Captain is responsible for that distribution. Such checks will include any money won from Singles Options, if any.
12. **Optional "Side Action" Events:** \$5.00 Scratch & Handicap Brackets. \$5.00 Brackets for Seniors (50+). \$40.00 High Game Scratch & Handicap Combo for all 3 games, allocated as \$5.00 Scratch & \$5.00 Handicap for Game #1 and Game #2, and \$10.00 Scratch & \$10.00 Handicap for Game #3. \$20.00 Mystery Score on all squads. The big paying "Quick Shot" (Strike) Jackpot. And the "Queen Of Hearts" game. Complete rules for these events will be posted at the check-in table. The Quick Shot Jackpot is partially explained below in rule #13. The Queen of Hearts is partially explained on the website. Also in play will be a \$100.00 Scratch event known as the "Jamz Moonlight Shootout" eliminator (cut the field) on Saturdays on the 4pm squad, as well as the second Sunday 4pm squad. This is explained on Page 4 of this entry form, below.
13. **Quick Shot (QS) Jackpot Partial Rules:** These are partial QS rules; complete rules will be available on site. The QS requires buy-in of \$5.00 or \$10.00 per ticket, no limit. One ticket will be drawn. The bowler holding the ticket must strike the next time up in tournament play, and if so, the bowler wins the jackpot. If no strike, bowler receives a consolation prize, and a 2nd ticket is drawn. Strike to win it all, or get a consolation. **If 2 tickets are drawn, and neither bowler strikes, the balance rolls over into the next squad of the tournament with one exception. If the QS is not won on the 4pm squad on Sunday, August 30, 2026, and/or the 4pm squad on Monday, September 7, 2026, it is guaranteed to be forced out on that squad with additional tickets drawn until won. There are no carryovers allowed from one weekend to the next, other than the Queen Of Hearts game.** At the discretion of the Tournament Director, some squads may feature a seeding of the jackpot pool before tickets are sold, and this will be announced prior to that squad starting. In the event of a large carryover/heavy sales, the jackpot pool may be allocated into more than one jackpot. No less than 85% of sales comprises the jackpot for each squad, plus carryover, if any. No more than 15% is allocated towards Tournament Expenses.
14. Any other situations not covered here will be rendered by the Tournament Director, Suheil Jammal, II, and those decisions shall be final.

“Jamz Moonlight Shootout”

Only available on Saturday, August 29, 2026, on the 4pm squad,
Saturday, September 5, 2026, on the 4pm squad, and
Sunday, September 6, 2026, on the 4pm squad,
the “Jamz Moonlight Shootout” is an ALL SCRATCH “cut the field” event.

In Game #1, as you are bowling the tournament,
you are up against all the bowlers who entered this event.

The goal is to make it to the top 8 scorers after all bowlers have completed Game #1.

After Game #2, the top 4 advance into Game #3.

After Game #3, the top 2 scorers go head to head for all the money in a very special event.

In the top 2 finals, in front of all bowlers after the 4pm squad concludes,
The lights are turned off, the lanes glow, special lighting is initiated, the music is turned up, and more.

The top 2 bowl (4) first balls only.

A strike = 10 points. A 9 count = 9 points. All spares are re-set and are meaningless.

After 4 balls, the highest point total is the winner!

This is a 100% payout, and top 2 win all the money.

Example: If 20 bowlers enter, a \$2,000.00 prize pool is generated,

1st place would pay \$1,300.00, with 2nd place paying \$700.00.

You can buy into this any time after the 12pm squad is completed and before the 4pm squad begins.

HOST HOTEL ... HOWEVER ...

Because most bowlers prefer to stay where they want to stay
so they can earn points at certain hotel chains,
or they are booking through app related services, timeshares, etc.,
there is no host hotel being utilized nearby.

However, **THE FLORIDA HOTEL**

Is a year round host hotel for The Jamz Tournament bowlers,
But it requires about a 30 minute drive, if no traffic, to get to Bowlero Altamonte.

Every bowler who has stayed at this venue has told me they love it,

And it's a beautiful hotel. And the rate is beyond good.

It is not a typical chain hotel. You must book through my website at
